

15 Village of Greenville Court House being within the same square that the said Tabitha now resides and joining the last piece of land formerly sold by the said Vardry to her beginning at a stake on the street that runs between the said Tabitha's lot and Baylis & Earles Esqr and runs thence north 16 East along the said street one hundred feet to a stake or to run to the stake which was drove up by John yesterday when run being the distance that will make the whole lot to run two hundred feet along the said street after allowing five feet from the center of the green tree for the beginning of the first piece of land sold by the said Vardry to the said Tabitha Curtis dated 7th day of June 1821 and runs thence down or through the land cultivated by David Henning North 74 West two hundred feet to a stake thence South 16 West one hundred feet to a stake or line of land previously sold to said Tabitha thence South 74 East to the beginning together with all and singular the rights members and appertinances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Tabitha Curtis her heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Tabitha Curtis her heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand and seal this 20th day of December 1831
