To all to whom these presents shall come.

I William Blasingame Sheriff of Greenville District and State aforesaid send Greeting  
 Whereas by virtue of sundry writ of Fieri Facias, issued out of the Court of Common  
 Pleas, held for the District of Greenville tested the second day of March in the  
 Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-two at the suit of John  
 P. Pool to me directed, commanding me, that of the Goods and Chattels, Lands  
 and Tenements of W.P. Pool & Seth P. Pool to levy the sum of One Hundred and  
 Twenty one Dollars damages and Costs, I have seized and taken of the Lands and  
 Tenements of the said William P. Pool - all that certain piece, parcel and  
 tract of land, containing One Hundred and Fifty Acres, situate and being in the  
 District of Greenville on the north side of Mash Creek the waters of South  
 Tyger River, adjoining Washington Nichols, William Jackson and James  
 McKinney for a more particular referment formerly belonging to Maza &  
 Smith and Whence the said premises, with their appurtenances, since the seizure  
 by me made, by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias before mentioned, have  
 been exposed to Sale at public Vendue, and purchased by John P. Pool of  
 the District of Greenville for the sum of Ninety five Dollars being the highest  
 sum that was bid therefor: NOW KNOW YE, that I, William Blasingame, Sheriff  
 aforesaid, by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid, to me directed  
 and delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and  
 provided, and for and in Consideration of the sum of Ninety five Dollars  
 to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said John P. Pool the receipt  
 and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained and sold,  
 and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said John P. Pool, his  
 heirs and assigns forever, the said tract, piece and parcel of land, with  
 its appurtenances, and all the estate, right, title and interest which the  
 said William P. & Seth P. Pool of right had, of, in, and to the same: To  
 Have and to Hold the said piece, parcel and tract of land, with its appur-  
 tenances unto the said John P. Pool, his heirs and assigns forever, as fully  
 and absolutely as I, the said W. Blasingame might, could, or ought  
 to grant, bargain and sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid,  
 and the said writ of Fieri Facias or otherwise. In witness whereof

 seal the tenth day of May in the Year of our Lord One Thousand  
 Eight Hundred and Thirty Two
