Know all men by these presents that I William Stone Senior of Greenville district in the State aforesaid in consideration of one hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Micajah Stone of the State and district aforesaid have granted Bargained Sold and released and by these presents do Grant Bargain Sell and Release unto the Said Micajah Stone all that plantation or tract of Land containing one hundred and Seventeen acres more or less Situate in the district of Greenville: Lying on the Branches of Mountain Creek waters of Salludica River Beginning on a white oak 3x running thence N. 36 1/2 E. 21.50 to a white oak 3x thence S. 43. W. 16.00 to a stake 3x thence N. 10. E. 3.60 to a stake 3x thence N. 82. W. 35.75 to a hickory 3x thence S 6 1/2 W 30.50 to a small red oak 3x all bounding on Joseph McCulloughs land thence S. 84. E. 34.50 to a rock 3x Bounding on the said Micajah Stones thence N. 24. E. 1.40 to the Beginning Together with all and singular the Rights members here detements and appurtenances to the Same Belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned to him and his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to Warrant and forever defend all and singular the Said premises unto the said Micajah Stone his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against Every other person or persons Whomesoever Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and Seal this Twelfth day of April Anno domini one thousand Eight hundred and thirty two and in the 56th year of the American Independence

E. Duncan of the district and State aforesaid the Receipt of Which is hereby Acknowledged have granted Bargained Sold and released and by these presents do Grant Bargain Sell and Release unto the Said J. E. Duncan all that Tract or parcels of Land Situate Lying and being in the district and State aforesaid on the South Side of Tyger River and is composed of three separate purchases of Land by the Said John E Brown (viz) one from Street Thurston deceded the twenty second day of October one thousand Eight hundred and Twenty Six (1826) for Two hundred and seventy
