Eighteen year old Sarah a negro girl about seven years of age and a parilla
aboy about five years of age to have and to hold the same in trust to and
for the following use and purpose to wit, for the use and benefit of my
said Daughter Clarissa during her life and after her death to such person
or persons as she may by deed or will notwithstanding her Coverture choose
to give it and in the event of the said Clarissa dying without executing
a lawfull deed or will then and in that case the said negroes and their Ince-
-ase are to Revert back to my Estate and to be Equally divided among her
brothers and sisters share and share alike and it is expressly understood
to be the Intention and provision of this deed of trust that the negroes
