Catolet River Beginning at a red oak thence N 18 W 42 chains 20 links to achesnut thence N 10 E 19 chains to achesnut thence N 55 E 17 chains 60 links to achesnut thence S 25 E 9 chains to achesnut thence S 73 E 8 chains 20 links to a poplar thence south course to a line known by William and John McClendon's line thence with their line to the beginning containing one hundred acres be the same more or less it being the upper end of a tract granted to William Jameson by patent bearing date 3rd April 1790 from him formerly to John Gowen from him to John Townsend from him to John Whorton and from him to me Together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appertinances thereunto belonging or in any ways appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the above mentioned premises unto the said John Waldrip his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs and Executors to warrant and forever defend the above mentioned premises unto the said John Waldrip his heirs and assigns forever against myself my heirs Executors and Administrators and against every person or persons Whomesoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
