hundred and five dollars to me paid by William G. Woodson of the same
place have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William G. Woodson
all that tract of land situate in the district of Greenville and State of
South Carolina on the Waters of the South Syger containing two hundred
and Sixty four acres be the same more or less being the same tract that
Kinson McVay conveyed to James Adams by deed dated the Eleventh
day of March 1807 to which deed reference is to be had as a part of
this title and sold by me this day at Public Sale under the order of
the Court of Equity for Greenville district passed at June Term 1827
to pay the debts of the said James Adams as will appear by reference to the
Journals of the said Court together with all and singular the rights members
Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said William G. Woodson his heirs and assigns for
Ever and I do hereby bind myself heirs Executors and administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto
the said William G. Woodson his heirs and assigns against myself and
my heirs and against no one else whatsoever Witness my hand and
seal this Fifth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand
Eight hundred and thirty two and in the fifty seventh year of the
