West 3.80 to a ^{thence} S 87 E 18.20 to a hickory ^{thence} N 87 E 2.85
to a post oak ^{thence} N 40 W 182 to the creek ^{thence} up said creek
to the beginning Including four acres more or less it being a part
of the tract on which I now live To Have and to hold the said
parcel or tract of Land Together with all and singular the
rights members Here detachments and appertinances belonging
or in any wise appertaining and I do hereby bind myself my
heirs & to warrant and ever defend the said bargained
premises unto the said George Seaburn his heirs & forever a
gainst me and my heirs and against every other person
or persons claiming the or any part thereof Witness my hand
and seal this 12th day of January A. D. 1831
