E. 4 chains to a stone 3x thence S. 60. E. 4 chains to a stone 3x thence S. 36. W. 4 chains to Black oak 3x thence N. 60. W. 4 chains to the Beginning which contains the Land to be conveyed to Said church for the Express purpose of a lot
