Elisha Nelson died Seized and possessed containing three hundred and seventy  
three acres be the Same more or less bounded by land running from a rock 37  
Sidesh books line S 5 E 37.50 to a spanish oak now obliterated the corner of a tract  
Granted to Andrew Thompson, thence on the line of the Same S 85 W 65 to a water  
37 thence on Brasher Hendersons line N 20 W 45 to his corner a black oak ob  
-literated thence on his line to Rocky Creek N 55 W 11 thence up the Same by its Mea  
to blacks now Goldsmiths line thence on the Same 20 chains to a post oak. 37 thence  
S 54 E on Wards line 25.50 to the corner a dead red oak thence S 85 E 30 to the  
Beginning together with all and Singular the rights, menses & cetera terms and  
appurtenances to the Said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or app  
-taining to have and to hold the premises as above described to the Said  
Woodsides his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs  
Executors &c to Warrant and forever defend the Same to the Said James Woodsides  
and his against me and mine and against Every other person or persons  
Lawfully claiming the Same or any part thereof in Witness of which  
I have hereunto Set my hand and affixed my Seal this 20<sup>th</sup> day of June
