E. Ward to a stake 3x thence Running 5 & a half chain to Pyle branch thence up Said Branch to a poplar stump near Benjamin Pollards Mill thence along a conditional line to a stake 3x thence S. 40. W. to a hickory corner thence S. 30 E 9 chains 75 links to a black oak 3x thence N 40 E 22 chains to Pyle Branch thence Running N 70 E along John Alexanders line to the Ruddy fork creek thence Running up Said Creek and binding on the Same to the Beginning 3x Including one hundred and fifty five acres of land more or less Together with all and Singular the rights members Hereditaments to the Said premises Belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and Singular the premises before mentioned unto the Said James D Ashmore his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to Warrant and forever defend all and Singular the Said premises unto the Said James D Ashmore his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns against Every other person or persons Whomsoever lawfully claiming the Same or any part thereof In Witness Whereof I have set my hand and Seal Sept 30th 1833

South Carolina } Know all men by these presents that I William Green of the Greenville District } District and State aforesaid in consideration of the Sum of five hundred and fifty dollars to me paid by Abraham Green of the Same State and district have granted Bargained Sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain Sell and release unto the Said Abraham Green certain tract of land Situate in Said district on Both forks of brushy creek of Enoree River it being part of a tract of land originally granted to George Lewis and conveyed by him to Baron Kemp and from Said Kemp to Edward Allen from Said Allen to the aforesaid William Green and both such Bounds Marks &c as follows (viz) Beginning at a small poplar 3x of E. Crofts land near the ford on the Branch In the present road leading from Said William Greens to C. Waddells thence N 18 E 39 chains to a black oak 3x thence N 70 E 10 chains to a stake 3x thence N 39 W. 50 chains to a red
