be the same more or less Together With all my Interest thereunto belonging or
in any wise appertaining unto the Said Robinson Earle and his heirs Executors
administrators and assigns forever and I the Said Robert Cox from myself my
heirs administrators Executors and assigns and from Every other person or persons
Whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the Same Shall and Will Warrant
and forever defend the half of Said premises which is my Interest to Said
Robinson Earle his heirs administrators &c In Witness Whereof I have hereunto
Set my hand and affixed my seal this 8th day of January 1834

that I the Said William Mcgregor for the Better Securing the payment of the Said
Sum of one hundred dollars unto the Said David Long his heirs Executors admi-
nistrators or assigns together with Lawfull Interest for the Same have Bargained
and Sold and by these presents do Bargain and Sell in plain and open Market
Deliver unto the Said David Long certain Chariot or Barouche lately owned
by Rowline Lowndes to have and to hold the Said Chariot or Barouche afo-
said unto the Said David Long his heirs Executors administrators and assigns
forever Provided always Nevertheless that if the Said William Mcgregor his
heirs Executors or administrators shall and do well and truly pay or cause
to be paid unto the Said David Long his certain attorney Executors admi-
nistrators or assigns the full and Just Sum of one hundred dollars according
to the true Intent and meaning of the Said Bond and of these presents together
with Lawfull Interest that may accrue thereon then this deed of Bargain
and Sale and all and every clause article and thing therein contained shall
bease determine and be utterly void and of none Effect any thing herein contained
