Wynn of the district and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the Sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars to me in hand paid by Roger Loveland and Company of the district and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold released and conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain sell release and convey unto the said Roger Loveland and Company and their heirs and assigns one Share or Childs part of the tract of Land which my mother now lives upon lying on the Western road adjoining Lands belonging to the Estate of the late Capt William Goling on the one Side and Lands now belonging to Doct William Robinson and William B. Johnson which my mother by the Will of my father is entitled to keep and enjoy during her live and which after her death is to be equally divided among the Children to have and to hold all such part of the said Land as I may at the death of my mother be entitled to or to my distributive Share of the said tract should it be sold for partition and full power and authority is hereby given and granted to the said Roger Loveland & Co to use my name in the recovery thereof to sue for the same and in every respect to take such steps as I might or should take was I present to do the same personally and all such Sum or Sums of money as they may receive in the premises on my account when recovered to apply to their own use and I do hereby warrant and defend all and Singular the said piece part or parcel of Land or the proceeds thereof to the said Roger Loveland and Company and their heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every other person or persons claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In Testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal at Greenville Court House this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of March A.D. 1832
