for and in consideration of the Sum of Seven hundred dollars to me  
in hand paid by Alfred Gilbeath of the district and State aforesaid  
have Granted bargained sold and released and by these presents  
do Grant bargain Sell and Release unto the Said Alfred Gilbeath  
all that tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and sixty  
two acres more or less Situate lying and being in Greenville District  
on both sides of Wolf Creek a branch of ~~the~~ <sup>Enore</sup> River beginning on the  
South side of Said Creek on a pine 3x thence N. 3. E. 26. 50 to a light wood  
Stake on Jenkins's line thence N. 61. E. 42. 75 to a red or black Oak 3x thence  
S. 25. E. 15. 50 to a post Oak 3x thence due East to the river Enore 29. 50 thence  
down Said River to the mouth of Wolf Creek thence up the Said Creek  
to the mouth of a small branch to a white oak 3x thence South 71. W. 45  
25 on land of Jacobs's to a hickory stump thence S. W. to the begin-  
-ing Pine Corner Together with all and singular the rights mem-  
-bers Hereditaments and appertainances to the Said premises  
Belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and  
to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto  
the Said Alfred Gilbeath his heirs and assigns forever and I  
do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators  
to Warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before  
mentioned unto the Said Alfred Gilbeath his heirs and assigns against  
myself and my heirs and against Every other person or persons whom-  
-soever lawfully claiming or to claim the Same or any part thereof
