for an inconsideration of the sum of two hundred and seventy  
five dollars to me paid by John P. Shockley of the same  
State and district have granted bargained sold and released  
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and unto  
the said John P. Shockley a certain tract of land situate  
in said district on Brush Creek of Enoree River con-  
taining one hundred and twenty two acres more or less  
it being part of a tract of land formerly owned by  
Alexander Waddill and hath such bounds marked &c  
as follows (viz) Beginning at a W. Ok 3x on Brush Creek on  
Mr. Forters line thence N. 40. W. 20 chs to a small pine 3x thence N. 50. E. 6. 30  
chs to a P. Ok 3x thence S. 40. W. 14. 40 to a P. Ok 3x thence S. 51. E. 18. 85 chs  
to a red oak 3x thence S. 42. E. 2. 70 chs to a sweet Gum 3x on a branch  
thence down the Meander of said branch to a maple 3x at the  
Junction of said branch with Brush Creek thence up the  
meander of Brushy Creek to the Beginning which will more  
fully appear on reference to a plat hereunto annexed  
together with all and singular the rights members &c  
determinations and appertanances to said premises belong-  
ing or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and  
to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned  
unto the said John P. Shockley his heirs and assigns for  
Ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors  
and administrators to warrant and forever defend all  
and singular the D. premises unto the D. John P. Shockley  
his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and a-  
gainst Every person whomsoever lawfully claiming  
or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my  
hand and seal this the second day of March in the  
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
thirty five and in the fifty ninth year of American  
Independence
