Blasingame might could or ought to grant bargain or sell the same by virtue of the statute aforesaid and the said writ of Fieri Facias or either or in witness whereof I the said W. Blasingame have hereunto set my hand and seal the third day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five and the 60<sup>th</sup> year of America Independence
