situate in the district aforesaid on Gilders Creek waters of Enoree River having
plain settings and Boundaries as shall be mentioned viz Beginning at the
North fork of the Creek on a maple three East of North to a pine near the grave
yard thence North 1° west to a stake Hamby's line thence South & East to the
North fork of the Creek thence down said Creek Mcneely's line to yeargain
line thence said line up the Creek to the Beginning corner including the
whole containing fifty four acres more or less being part of a tract of land
formerly belonging to Richard Serugo Together with all ~~rights~~ the
rights members Hereditaments appertaining to the said premises
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all
and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Revenue yeargain
his heirs or assigns forever and I do bind myself my heirs Executors Admors
ministrators or assigns to Warrant and Defend all and singular the
premises to the said Revenue yeargain his heirs assigns against me my
heirs and assigns as witness my hand and Seal this 10th November 1835
one thousand Eight hundred and thirty five
