Thompson and others to said Jeremiah Cleveland & together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said one fifth part of the said tract of land belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to him and to hold the said one fifth part of the said tract of land and of the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the same belonging unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland & his heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby bind ourselves his Executrix Administratrix and assigns firmly by these presents to warrant and forever defend all the right title and interest that we now have or may hereafter have to the above mentioned one fifth of said tract of land unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland and his heirs forever against our selves and our heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever claiming or to claim the said one fifth of the said tract of land or any part of the said one fifth which we claim under the will of the said Josiah Thompson Deceased In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this the 21st day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five and in the Sixty sixth year of the sovereignty and independence of the United States of America signed sealed and delivered in the presence of Barnett A.
