granted Micajah sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain
and release unto the said Micajah Jordan all that parcel or tract of
land containing forty and a half acres more or less situated in the District
aforesaid lying on the waters of Mountain Creek Beginning at Rock it thence
125 & 36 00 to a Hickory 3 + staves S. 43 W. 13. 25' to a post oak 3 + staves
163 W. 2. 20 to a Red oak 3 + staves N. 72 W. 18. 00 to a Hickory 3 + staves
110. 2. 20 the beginning together with all and singular stock rights, members
before mentioned and appertaining to the same belonging or in any wise incident
thereunto pertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises above
mentioned unto the said Micajah Jordan his heirs and assigns forever
and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises
unto the said Micajah Jordan his heirs and assigns against my self
and my heirs and against every other persons whomsoever hee may
claiming or to claim the same or any part therof witness, in this hand
that this the twelfth day of December in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and thirty five
