 in the Claim and demand both at Law and Equity and as well in Replevin and
 Distress of in and to all that certain farm or piece of land that was de-
 ced to them by the said deceased situate in Greenville District on Rockey Creek
 River the quantity of land conveyed is one third part of the tract
 Land whereon the said Deceased Samuel Walker did live Sighnowe to
 two hundred acres in said tract said Land granted to Joseph Woodall
 and he has released from him to the said Deceased with all and singular the Rights
 in said Land heretofore determinants and appertaining thereto Belonging in
 two acre tracts whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 1st March
