 sum of three hundred and fifty seven dollars to me paid by Micajah Stone of the
 State and district aforesaid hath granted bargained sold and released and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Micajah Stone one plantation
 on and tract of Land ^{lying in the State of South Carolina} including the plantation where James Smith now lives
 beginning on creek 3x near Micajah Jordans Spring Thence S 25 E 30 to a hickory 3x 1 thence
 S 115 W 15 to a post oak 3x bounded on Micajah Jordans Land Thence N 62 W
 21 68 to a stake 3x Thence N 12 E 3 58 to a red oak 3x Thence N 88 W 35 62 to a
 hickory 3x Thence S 11 W 10 to a creek 3x bounded on William Stones Land deceased
 the late Micajah Stone Thence N 62 W 20 to a cypress on the said mountain
 creek Thence up the meanders of said creek to the mouth of a branch thence
 up the meanders to a pine 3x Thence North 84 W E 37 to a hickory 3x Thence N 39 E 15 50 to
 a oak on the beginning rock bounded on Strother & Shumate's land including one hundred
 and seventy eight acres and a half be the same more or less together with all and
 singular the rights members here detriments and appurtenances to the said
 post oak plantation belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to
 hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Micajah
 Stone his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs
 executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular
 the said premises unto the said Micajah Stone his heirs and assigns against
 me myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and
 seal this second day of September in the year of our lord one thousand
 eight hundred and thirty five and in the sixty sixth year of American
 Independence signed sealed & Delivered

 mentioned and released Given under my hand and seal this 2nd
 day of September 1835 }
