the district of Greenville and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of two thousand  
and fifty dollars to me paid by William Pollard of the district aforesaid  
or any part thereof granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do by and have  
done full and release unto the said William Pollard one hundred acres of land more  
or less lying in Greenville district on a branch of reedy River known by the name of  
the Pigeon Rust part of which was granted to Hance Black part to James William,  
part to John Pyle and others the said one hundred acres of land is laid out  
unto the said William Pollard as follows beginning at a post oak at Chambers  
Pollard meeting house on the original line there abouts 40 rods and so links to a post  
at the head of said Branch thence down the said Branch with the meanders below  
Lindemanns old House to a maple corner there running through the old field  
above the brook from N.W. ward to a post oak on Lindemanns line there west  
ward to black Jack corner on Lindemanns old line then running Northward  
to the original pine corner on Mayhalls Land there 4 E to Pollards land  
then running N.E. ward with Pollards land to the original corner on Chambers  
land then running with Pollards land to Lindemanns land then to the beginning  
including one hundred acres of land more or less together with all and singular
