have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bas  
e and release unto the said William Pollard one hundred acres of land more  
or less lying in Greenville district on a branch of reedy River known by the name of  
the Ridgion Rust part of which was granted to Hance Black part to James McWilliam  
and part to John Pyle and others the said one hundred acres of land is laid out  
unto the said William Pollard as follows beginning at a post oak at Chambers  
Pollard's hunting house on the original line thence N.W. 1/4<sup>th</sup> 50 chains and 50 links to a post oak  
Pollard's at the head of said branch thence down the said branch with the meanders below  
Card's Lindermans old House to a maple corner thence running through the old field  
of Man's above the crop fence N.W. ward to a post oak on Lindermans line thence west
