 Greenville District B. M. Lynch of the District State of South
 to me in hand paid by John P. Pool of this place have granted
 bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell
 and release unto the said John P. Pool a certain tract or parcel
 of Land Situate in the District aforesaid on the waters of Tyger
 River beginning at the mouth of the same near painters
 running with said Pool's Land and line to a Red Oak Thence
 with said Pool's Land and line to a Small Red Oak Thence with
 said William Pool's Land thence to a Red Oak Thence with said
 Pool's Land thence to a post Oak Thence with Sam Goehaus Land
 thence to a Spanish Oak Thence with Col Hodges Land thence to the
 beginning containing two hundred and thirty one and a half ac.
 more or less the right members hereditaments and appurtenances the
 said premises belonging or in any wise incident to have and to
 hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto
 the said John P. Pool his heirs and assigns for ever from me
 my heirs and assigns every other person or persons whatsoever
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
 in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 29th
 March 1835 in the presence of B. M. Lynch Seal
