 in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars
 to us in hand paid by Abraham Green of the State of Georgia
 Cash County have granted Bargained sold and release
 and by their presents do grant bargain sell and release
 to the said Abraham Green a tract or parcel of Land lying
 and being in the District of Greenville on both sides of
 Green's Creek a branch of South Pasquot River beginning
 at a Red Oak near a branch Stephen Johnson's Course
 running thence N 22 E to a white Oak thence S 62 W 28 E
 to a Florida Chestnut thence N 10 E 36 E to a Stake thence N 48 W
 to a hickory John Evans course thence N 10 E 32 E
 to a large poplar thence N 25 E 12 E to a Stake thence S 70 E
 20 E to a Stake Stephen Johnson's Course thence a
 tract line nearly a South course with said Johnson's line
 at the head of the nearest branch thence down the one
 hundred thereof to the creek thence up one other branch
 that enters in on the south and other side to the beginning
 containing by estimation three hundred acres be the same
 more or less being a part of a tract of Land originally
 by patent bearing date June the 5th 1786 unto Zephaniah and
 the other part of a tract granted unto Richard Brasille
 by patent bearing date July 1st 1793 former being had
 to the several conveyances thence to be making will make
 the title fully appear to have and to hold all and
 singular the premises above mentioned (except about
 fifty acres more or less on the North west side claimed
 by the Peaces by Elder Smith) unto the said Abraham
 Green and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs
 Executors and Administrators to warrant and defend
 the above mentioned premises with (above exceptions)
 unto the said Abraham Green his heirs and assigns
 against us and our heirs and against every person
 or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim
 the same or any part thereof (with above exceptions) in
 witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and
 seals this the 19th day of March in the year of our Lord
 eighteen hundred and thirty six and thirtieth year of
