Sumville District & Ezekiel Henderson of the State aforesaid

Said in consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear towards my son Thomas Henderson hath given and granted and by these presents doth grant unto the said Thomas Henderson his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of Land wheresoever the said Thomas Henderson now lives being a tract of Land of 1300 acrs conveyed to Ezekiel Henderson by Samuel Earle the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of January 1818 and a part of an adjoining tract of Land of 80 acrs conveyed to Ezekiel Henderson by James Travis the 10<sup>th</sup> day of September 1792 having such papers and forms as are further explicated by plats and deeds that are in the possession of the said Thomas Henderson with a reserved Right of the said premises to the said Ezekiel Henderson during his natural life and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas Henderson his heirs and assigns against all claims that now is and against every person whoansoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this tenth day of March in the thousand Eight Hundred and thirty six and in the sixteenth year of the Independence of the United States of America Signed Seal and Acknowledged in the presence of
