by Hiram Cooley (to each) of the District State aforesaid have said  
granted bargained sold and released and by these presents  
do Grant bargain sell and release unto the said Hiram Cooley  
Cooley all our Interest Right title & claim or demand  
in or to all that parcel or tract of land originally  
Granted to James Hainsaw on the twenty eighth day of  
November 1793 reference being thereunto had well more  
fully appear situate in the District aforesaid and bounded  
by Samuel Williams Samuel Ward and said Hiram Cooley  
together with all and singular the rights members here  
appertaining and appurtenances to the said premises belong-  
ing or in anywise incident or appertaining to Hainsaw  
and to hold all and singular the premises before men-  
tioned unto the said Hiram Cooley his heirs & assigns for  
ever and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors  
and Adors to warrant and forever defend all singular  
the said premises unto the said Hiram Cooley his heirs & assigns  
against ourselves and our heirs in any other person  
or persons who or whose lawfully claiming or to claim  
the same in any part thereof Witness our hands and  
Seals this the fourth day of February one thousand  
eight hundred and thirty three and in the fifty sixth  
year of the Independence of the United States of  
America Signed sealed and delivered in presence of  
George Brooks
