South Carolina This Indenture made the 18<sup>th</sup> day of January in  
the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Ninety  
Between James Wood of the one part and George Marchbanks  
& Elias Marchbanks of the other part witnesseth that whereas  
the said Marchbanks's Hand indented to the said James Wood in the  
full sum of four hundred and thirteen dollars by their Note  
of hand bearing Interest from the first day of August payah  
the 1<sup>st</sup> January 1839 Now this Indenture witnesseth that the  
said George & Elias Marchbanks for and in consideration of  
the said sum or sum payable as aforesaid to the said James  
Wood and for the better Securing the payment thereof to the  
said James Wood according to the tenor and effect of the  
Note aforesaid and also in Consideration of our debt to  
the said George & Elias Marchbanks in hand paid at &  
before the Sealing & delivery of these presents do Recant her  
- said full and Release Convey and Confirm unto the said  
James Wood and to his heirs and assigns for ever all that tract  
or Plantation of Land lying in Greenville District on Enoe  
River & branches thereof containing One Thousand & Sixty  
three acres by the same more or less beginning on the North  
Side of Enoe River on a line running Thence \$20 E 28°  
to a Church on the South Side of the River Thence S. 85° 19' E.  
a post Oak Thence N 33 E. 17.50 to a Sweet Gum on the South  
Side the River & a Maple on the North Side of the said  
Thence following the line of the Creek until it inter-  
sects the part Aaron Lump sold off to George Sauter  
thence along Sauter's line until it intersects a part of  
Land sold off of the same Grant to James Wood thence  
a long wood's line until it intersects the line of the original  
Grant thence a long Gaice line to the beginning  
from Conner also all that tract or parcel of Land  
containing Thirty seven acres by the same more  
or less Conveyed by Rubin Ayers to Aaron Lump and  
by Lump Conveyed to the said George & Elias Marchbanks  
beginning on a point near on the bank of Enoe River at a mill  
place running Thence 88 1/2 E. 30 Ch to a small post Oak 3x all the  
Rutherford Road thence with said Road N 10 E. 14. Ch to a P.  
thence N 46 W. 10. Ch to post 3x thence (\$30 44 25. 00) to a pine 3x then  
thence S 40 W. 8. to the beginning Conner Together with all  
such furniture the eight hundred and six parts and the  
water hanging or in any wise appertaining to the tract
