Whereas I the said John T. Coleman has this day purchased for  
Daniel H. Lowndale of Greenville district South Carolina Lots or parcels of lands situate  
lying and being in the District of Greenville Village of Greenville state of South Carolina  
and comprise some eight minus ten thirteen in the original plan of the village and more particularly  
in the said description in the deed of conveyance from the said Daniel H. Lowndale to me being  
the said Lot or lots which the mansion House stands on which the stables unstanding  
which are attached to the said Mansion House & being the same Lots which were  
some time since purchased by me and the said Daniel H. Lowndale of Dr  
John Crittenden & by me afterwards conveyed to the said Daniel H. Lowndale  
and whereas I have this day purchased of the said Daniel H. Lowndale  
the Store House near the Mansion House & formerly occupied by Paul  
Crayton as a Store and tenantry by Joseph Powell as a Grocery and  
whereas I have also purchased of the said Daniel H. Lowndale the lease of  
the Ground on which the said Store House stands which was obtained by  
the said D. H. Lowndale of Jeremiah Cleeland the owner of the said  
Ground above mentioned and whereas I have also this day obligated  
and bound myself unto the said Daniel H. Lowndale to pay all the  
notes obligations & demands which John Crittenden holds against the  
said Lowndale & myself for the purchase money of the said Man-  
sion House & also for furniture & other articles purchased of the said  
Crittenden and whereas I have obligated & bound myself to pay

to pay the balance due Joseph Powell for the Store House above mentioned  
and to release the said D. H. Lowndale from all obligations which  
he may at this time be under for the said Mansion House & Store House  
Now know all men that I John T. Coleman in consideration of the  
promises above mentioned & for the better securing the payments  
above referred to and the compliance of the terms of agreement  
above referred to according to the stipulations & conditions thereof  
and also in consideration of the further sum of three dollars to me  
the said John T. Coleman in hand paid and truly paid by the said  
D. H. Lowndale at and before the making and delivering of these presents  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged & the said John T. Coleman  
has granted bargained sold and released & by these presents do Grant  
bargain sell also release unto the said Daniel H. Lowndale all those  
Lots or parcels of Land situate lying & being in the Village of  
Greenville number seven, eight, nine, ten & thirteen in the original plan of  
the Village being the same on which the Mansion House stands and  
the stables unstanding which are attached to the Mansion House & all  
of which Lots are more particularly in the deed of conveyance from  
Dr John Crittenden to John T. Coleman & Daniel H. Lowndale & also  
in the deed from John T. Coleman to D. H. Lowndale and also in the  
deed this day made & executed by the said Daniel H. Lowndale to  
me the said John T. Coleman & also I the said John T. Coleman have  
granted bargained and sold and by these presents do Grant bargain and
