State of South Carolina & I know all men by these Presents that I Peter Hitt of the Greenville District of the State and District aforesaid are held for any us - Considerations of one hundred Dollars to me in hand paid By Robert Hitt have Bargained sold a plantation or tract of Land containing fifty acres more or less situated in the District aforesaid by being on the north fork of Saluda River bounded as follows Beginning at a willow oak corner near Earles old Bridge on said River thence to a chestnut thence to a Black oak thence along the old Road until it strikes the head of the hollow which the spring is in thence down the spring Run a creek until it comes to Michael Whitmore thence along the same line until it comes to a chestnut corner on the Road thence along the Whitmore line until it strikes the aforesaid River thence up the River to the Beginning corner near the aforesaid Bridge with all and singular the premises above described appurtenances or anywise incident to the said premises unto said Robert Hitt his heirs and assigns for ever against my self my heirs or assigns or any other persons or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof as witnesses whereof I set my hand and seal August 20<sup>th</sup> 1830
