State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Anna
 Keepers, and heirs of Charles Moore deceased of Greenville District, in the state
 aforesaid, In consideration of one hundred and forty Dollars paid by John
 Ross of Greenville District and state aforesaid, The said Anna Keepers, and
 heirs, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
 do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Ross a plantation
 tract of Land containing ^{twenty} two acres lying in the District and state aforesaid
 on branches of Brushy Creek waters of Enoree River, it being a part
 of a tract of land originally granted to Henry Hughes dated the fifth day of
 February in the year of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred and eighty
 seven. Whereas beginning on a stake formerly a Hickory, thence N 40. W 150 to
 a stake in R. Ross field, thence S 70. W 28. to post Oak, thence S 57. W 11. 25
 to a R Oak corner, thence S. 10. E 13. 25 to a stake corner, thence S 70. E 16. 25
 to a stake corner, thence N 40. E 30. 50 to a black Oak corner thence N 4 W 11
 the beginning corner Together with all and singular the rights, members,
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise in-
 vent To have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned
 unto the said John Ross, his heirs & executors Administrators or assigns forever
 And we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs & executors Administrators or assigns
 warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises, unto the said
 John Ross, his heirs, and assigns against ourselves, and our heirs, and against
 any other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or claiming any part thereof
 In witness whereof Our hands and seals the day of January in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight, and in the fifty second year of the
 Independence of the United States of America. Signed sealed and delivered
 in the presence of us, Test, William Norris x Thomas Norris x Anna Moore (Seal)

 was a subscribing witness to the same sworn to and subscribed to before me
