running SE & SW by John Towles land SE & NE Eli Baldwins & Samuel
Howard's lands NW & SW by Solomon Hollands and by the said Bridge creek fork
Having such shape, form and marks as are represented by a plat hereunto an
nued, together with all woods, trees, waters, water-courses, profits commodi
ties appurtenances and hereditaments whatsoever thereto belonging.
To have and to hold the said tract of two hundred and fifty nine acres
of land, and all and singular, other the premises hereby granted unto
the said Bartlet Yeagin his heirs and assigns forever in fee and com
mon socage Given under the seal of the State held in presence, his Excellency
Pierce M. Butler esquire Governor and Commander in chief in and over
the said State, at Columbia, this 10th day of February Anno Domini, One
thousand eight hundred and thirty seven and in the sixty first year
of the Independence of the United States of America Tom Butler
