these presents bargained, sold and conveyed, and do hereby grant bargain, sell and convey and do  
hereby give and deliver to James Alexander his heirs and assigns for ever a tract of land in said District containing  
one and one half acres, be the same more or less wherein Alexander late had  
and held the waters of Rayborn's creek, bounded by lines of James Alexander on the North  
(Tegus River) South on the East & South East by Mike Peden & the Academy lot. Together  
with all and singular the rights, members, and appurtenances to the premises  
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold the same  
in full and Complete warranty against the heirs and assigns of the  
said John Alexander and every other person & persons lawfully claiming the  
same to性命 or any part thereof. In testimony of which we have hereunto set our  
hands and seals this fifteenth day of August 1837, in the presence of James H.  
Harrison. Thomas W. Alexander Executer for himself & Sarah Alexander  
of South Carolina. Personally came before me, a Justice of the peace for said District  
of Greenville District of James H. Harrison who being duly sworn and with uplifted  
hand that he was present and saw Thomas W. Alexander Executer and Sarah Alexander  
is and Executrix assign the within deed to James Alexander for the use and purposes within  
mentioned and that he saw John Peden sign as a witness with himself Sworn to
