

State<sup>312</sup> of South Carolina; This Indenture made this twenty first day of Greenville District<sup>3</sup> 3 April in the year of Our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and thirty four between John Watson Ordinary of said District and George Flemming of the same State and District Whereas a summons in action to divide or sell a certain lot of land situate in the town of Greenville I herein after described, belonging to the estate of Anne Logan late of said District deceased issued from the Court of Ordinary of said District, and upon the return thereof, the Judge of said Court did determine, that the said lot could not be divided without injury to the joint interest of the parties and did order the same to be sold by the Sheriff of the said District aforesaid on a credit of one year, whereupon the Sheriff aforesaid did advertise the said lot for sale on the first Monday of this instant. And whereas the said Sheriff, did on the same day expose to sale at public outcry on the credit aforesaid the said lot of land when the said Col George Flemming was the last and highest bidder, to whom the said lot was struck off for the sum of two hundred and eighty dollars Now this Indenture witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of two hundred and eighty dollars to me paid I have granted bargained, sold and released to the said Col George Flemming and his heirs and assigns for ever the said lot of land situate in the town of Greenville in the District aforesaid, Fronting on main street it being part of Lot #22 known and designated in the plan of said town adjoining lots belonging to said Flemming and B F Horton on main street and back by Brooks lot, with the appurtenances thereto belonging, and all the Estate, right, title Interest claim or demand which the said Anne Logan deceased, at the time of her death belonging to the same, to have and to hold the said lot of land together with all and singular the premises, improvements and appurtenances to the said Col George Flemming and his heirs and assigns for ever In witness whereof I the said John Watson as Ordinary aforesaid have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above mentioned John Watson E S O G D.
