

real singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
Church premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To Have
whom ever to hold full and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the
said Henry Cole, his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind
the year myself, my heirs executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend,
to the said singular the said premises, unto the said Henry Cole, his heirs &
assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whom
