

South Carolina: Know all men by these presents that I Varday M^c Bee of Greenville District of the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to me paid by I^s H^c Benedict of the Village of Greenville in the State aforesaid Have granted, bargain, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said I^s H^c Benedict all that lot of Land near the Village of Greenville on or near the Buncomb road (beginning) at a stake Hartwell Susters Corner near the Buncomb road and runs north 38 degrees West 200 feet to a stake on a street 50 feet wide, thence south 54 degrees West 300 feet along a line of the said street to a stake thence south 38 degrees East 200 feet to a stake on said Hartwell Susters line thence North 25 degrees East 300 along said Hartwell Susters line to the beginning) - to be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, manors, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said I^s H^c Benedict his Heirs and assigns, against myself, and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever, (badly claiming) or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and this thirteenth day of October in the year of our Lord, One thousand, eight hundred, and thirty seven and in the Sixty second year of the Independence of the United States of America Signed sealed, and delivered - Varday M^c Bee in the presence of Luther M^c Bee, Henry Cole & South Carolina: Personally appeared Henry Cole before me, and made Greenville District of the State aforesaid, sign, seal, and as his act and deed deliver the within deed for the uses and purposes therein mentioned, and that Luther M^c Bee, with himself, was a subscribing witness to the same Sworn to and subscribed before me this 14th day of Oct^r 1837.
