 released and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said
 Rubin Medlocke all that plantation or tract of land containing one
 hundred and thirteen acres (more or less, situate in the District of Greenville
 and State aforesaid lying on the waters of Mountain Creek, beginning
 in a hickory 37 and running thence S 36. E 41. 50 to a small hickory 37
 bounded by Joseph Medlocke's land, thence S 47. W 40. 50 to a rock 37
 bounded by Nathaniel Gains land, thence N 47. W 18. 25 to a rock 37
 thence N 13. E 38. 25 to the beginning) bounded by John Medlocke's land
 together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and
 appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or
 appertaining) To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the
 said Rubin Medlocke his heirs and assigns for ever And I do hereby bind
 myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend
 all and singular the said premises unto the said Rubin Medlocke his heirs
 and assigns against myself and my heirs, and against every other person
 whatsoever lawfully claiming) the same or any part thereof. Witness
 my hand and seal this the second day of January, in the year of our
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six. George French
 Signed sealed and Delivered in the presence of J. McDonald Nathaniel Gains.
