

State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents, that I George Ross of Greenville District of the District and State above mentioned for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred and twenty six Dollars to me in hand paid by John Green of the District and State above mentioned I have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John Green all that certain piece or parcel or tract of land lying on bushy creek, waters of Enoree river. Commencing on the north side of said Creek on a white Oak 3x, thence S 47. W 51 chains 58 links to a black Oak 3x, thence S 34. E 14 chains to pine 3x, thence N 40. E 5 chains to a stake 3x, thence N 62. E 15 chains. 36 links to a stake in the old field 3x, thence S 31. E 14. chains 50 links to a maple 3x, thence S 2. E 9 chains 50 links up the meanders of John Ross's spring branch to a sweet gum 3x, thence N 70. E 17 chains to a stake in the field, thence S 38. E 4 chains 40 links to a black Oak 3x, thence N 33. E on Wiley Kemp's line 25 chains to a black Oak 3x then N 41. W 45 chains 30 links to the beginning together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Green his heirs and assigns for ever: And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John Green, his heirs and assigns against myself, my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, this the eighteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven, and in the sixty second year of the Independence of the United States of America. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal, George Ross (S.S.) In the presence of Willis D. Thultheld. A.W. Crowder.
