Greenville District } Robert Hill of the State and District
aforesaid am held for and in consideration of One hundred and fifty Dollars
some in hand paid by Messrs Fendley Junr. Have bargained and sold, a
plantation or tract of Land containing fifty acres more or less situated in
the District aforesaid, lying on the north fork of Saluda River bounded as
follows, Beginning at a Willow Oak corner near Earle's Old bridge on
said river, thence to a Chesnut, thence to a black Oak, thence along the
old road untill it strikes the head of the hollow which the spring is in,
thence down the spring branch till it comes to Michael Whitmores
line, thence along the said line untill it comes to a Chesnut corner on the
road, thence along Jeremiah Whitmores line, till it strikes the afore-
said river, thence up the river to the beginning corner near the afore-
bridge. With all and singular the premises, Heretofore stated, appurtenances
or any wise incident to the said premises, unto the said Messrs Fendley
his Heirs, and assigns for ever against myself my Heirs or assigns
or any other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any
part thereof. As witness whereof I set my hand and seal this the 2^d
day of November One thousand eight hundred and thirty seven in the
