 Robbs, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and
 released all my part, right or title, and Judge Duman and Susannah Duman
 William Watson all their parts with our own. Have bargained sold
 and release all their parts to a certain tract of parcel of land containing
 one hundred and sixty laying in Greenville District and State aforesaid
 (it being a part of a tract of originally granted to John Watson laying on
 Prohawk Creek (beginning) on a pine N 58. W 90.40 to a stake thence S
 12. E 55.75. to a stake, thence N 84. E 21. 50. to a stake N 22. W 7.75 to a dogwood
 on the creek, thence with the meanders of the creek to white oak, thence to the
 (beginning) Together with all and singular rights, members, hereditaments
 and appurtenances (belonging), and we bind our selves, our heirs executors and ad-
 ministrators to warrant and firm any other person or persons claiming the
 same thereof unto the said William Robbs his heirs, and assigns forever from
 the claim of any persons lawfully claiming, the same or any part thereof sign-
 the witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seal this 19th day of
 the month of January 1837.
