Know all men by these presents, that I W^m Pollard of the District of Greenville, in the state aforesaid in consideration of the sum of fifty five Dollars to me paid by John S Mayfield of the state & District aforesaid. Have granted, bargained, sold and released unto the said John S Mayfield seventy five acres of land more or less it being part of a tract of land originally granted to Robert Gilliland, and signed by his Excellency William Moultrie on the 5th day of June seventeen hundred & eighty six the said seventy acres more or less lying on waters of the Keedyfork of Reddy River (the land is laid out as follows. Beginning on the great road on the original line joining P Lenderman's land along Saw line to A Blacks in a westerly direction, thence on the same line & course to a conditional red oak corner on Coxes line, thence running on a conditional line straight to G. Crofts corner in a branch near Coxes fence, thence up said branch near the head to a conditional line, then running that line to a road leading to Coxes, then a long said road in a N & E direction to a short line running to a conditional stone corner in the big road, then with the road to the beginning) including seventy five acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances to or in anywise incident or appertaining) I have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John S Mayfield his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said seventy five acres of land more or less with the premises unto the said John S Mayfield his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs and assigns & all and every other person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
