and fifty Dollars to me paid by Enoch Smith of the said State
and District aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and
release unto the said Enoch Smith a tract of land laying in
the State and District aforesaid on the waters of Needy fork
of Needy River, being part of a tract originally granted Benjamin
Farmer for 500 acres on the 3rd day of March 1800 &
recorded in Grant book UUUU page 279 including the house
and plantation where the said Enoch Smith now lives with to
one hundred acres of land, be the same beginning on a
Stake 37 on the original line, thence running N 20 W 43 to
a stake 37 bounded by William Hells land, thence S 60 W 25 to
a stake 37 thence S 20 E 16.50 to a stake 37, thence S 20 W 13
to a stake 37 bounded by Amos Askew, thence East 37.20 to the
beginning, bound by the said Willson Tollsion lands To go with
with all and singular the rights, revenues, appurtenances

and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, exec-
