and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said
Ethel Holycard his heirs and assigns for ever And I do hereby bind my
Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and for ever defend, all and singular
the said premises, unto the said Ethel Holycard his Heirs and assigns, against
myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming
to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this
one 10th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and thirty seven and in the forty second year of the Independence of the United
