gained sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, con-
vey (unto the said Samuel Morley) all that tract or parcel of land lying
North of the school house branch, containing four hundred acres,
more or less. Beginning on a white Oak corner on said schoolhouse, thence
to a black foot corner, thence to a pine corner, thence to a post corner, thence af-
ter along the old Ironworks road to a Spanish Oak corner on the said road,
thence down a small holler to a Turkey Oak corner, thence to a Spanish
Oak corner on the above mentioned branch, thence down the said branch
(the beginning). Together with all and singular the rights members
of all hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise
pertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises above
mentioned unto the said Samuel Morley his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do
hereby bind myself, my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever de-
sign and all and singular the said premises unto the said Samuel Morley his heirs and
assigns for ever against myself my heirs and against every person or persons
that soon lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. In witness whereof
