

Know all men by these presents that I Esq^r 60
of the State of South Carolina, Governor of the State and District aforesaid for
the Greenville District, in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to me in hand paid
by Samuel Mosley of the State and District aforesaid, have granted bar-
tained sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell
and convey unto the said Samuel Mosley, all that tract or parcel of land
lying north of the school house branch, containing four hundred acres
more or less. Beginning on a white oak corner on said schoolhouse, thence
to a black oak corner, thence to a pine corner, thence to a post oak corner, thence
along the old Ironworks road to a spanish oak corner on the said road,
thence down a small hollow to a turkey oak corner, thence to a spanish
oak corner on the above mentioned branch, thence down the said branch
(to the beginning). Together with all and singular the rights members
hereditaments and appurtenments to the said premises belonging or in anywise
appertaining). To have and to hold all and singular the said premises above
mentioned unto the said Samuel Mosley his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do
hereby bind myself, my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and for ever
to defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Samuel Mosley his heirs and
assigns for ever against myself my heirs and against every person or persons
whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. In witness
