

North Carolina Know all men by these presents, that I Jonathan Stokes<sup>525</sup> of  
Fremont District and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and nine  
Dollars and ninety one cents to me in hand paid by W. E. Wickliffe of Greenville  
State aforesaid, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bar-  
gained sold and conveyed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto  
the said Wickliffe a certain piece of land lying on the waters of Mountain  
Creek being surveyed and laid off as follows, Beginning on a Chestnut  
stump by Wickliffe's mill running thence S. 50 E. 12 chains 79 links to a  
stake, thence N 66 E 16 chains 50 links to a stake on the creek, thence up  
the meanders of said creek to the corner of the saw mill on the bank of the creek  
thence N 52 W 1 chain 55 links P.O. Stump thence N 88 W 6 50 to a red  
oak stump by a spring, thence S 70 W 1.70 to a red oak, thence N 69 W 3 ch  
to a post oak, thence S 68 W 3 70 to the beginning containing by estimate  
in 15 3/4 acres Together with all and singular the rights, liberties, and  
appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or apper-  
taining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned  
unto the aforesaid W. E. Wickliffe his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby  
bind myself my heirs and assigns to warrant and forever defend all  
and singular the said premises unto the said William E. Wickliffe his
