 beginning on a white oak, thence N 30 E 8 ch 25 links to a chestnut
 thence South 82 W 27 ch to a chestnut, thence S 2 W 22 ch to a red oak, thence
 N 45 E 16 ch 15 links to a chestnut oak, thence N 88 E 17 ch to a red oak, thence
 N 43 E 3 ch to a stake thence N 28 W 9 ch 20 links to a maple thence N
 58 W 4 ch 30 links to a stake thence N 30 E 14 ch 50 links to the beginning
 the white oak Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident
 or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before
 mentioned unto the said Willey Balloo his heirs and assigns for ever, And
 I do hereby bind myself, my heirs executors and administrators to warrant
 and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said
