with all and singular the rights members hereditarily appertaining to the
premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said George Cunningham his
heirs and assigns forever I do hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto George
Cunningham his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and every other
person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
