 love and good will which I have and do bear towards my son William H. Evans
 of the District and State aforesaid have given and granted and by these
 presents do freely give and grant unto the said William H. Evans a negro
 in the Eleventh Year of his age Called James who is a negro boy is now on
 my plantation in the District and State aforesaid (before the signing of
 these presents) I have delivered the said Negro boy to the said William H. Evans
 that he may have and hold him the said boy as his property property here-
 forth without any manner of condition I am witness of which I set my
 hand and seal this the tenth of November Eighteen hundred and thirty
 Eight (1838) Signed sealed and Delivered in presence of
 us William B. Garrison } Philip Evans
