Together with all and singular the rights and members, Privileges, and appurtenances, therunto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining - And I the said Burrell J Stewart do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors administrators and assigns, to forever warrant and defend the above granted premises, unto him the said Harmon Page his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs Executors administrators and assigns and against any other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty fifth day of February 1836 signed sealed and delivered in presence of

South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that James Sutherland of the State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of Forty Dollars to me in hand paid by Harmon Page of the State and District aforesaid have granted bargained and sold & released unto the said Harmon Page all that tract or parcel of land containing thirty six acres or the same more or less being and lying in the District aforesaid on both sides of the Beaver Dam Creek of Tige River Beginning on a post oak running S 47 to one Lapham Dill's line to R. 60 chains thence N 40 W 34 chains to Stake with Stewart line thence N 43 E 23 to stake on Stewart line near Allen Twitty's Chestnut corner thence S 70 W to R. 26 with Dickie's line thence S 9 50 to Dickie's Post oak corner To the beginning it being part of a tract of land granted to said Sutherland bearing date 30 day of March 1795 Together and singular the rights and members hereditaments therunto belonging to the said Harmon Page his heirs assigns & Executors & administrators forever I the said Sutherland do hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns & Executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend the said premises, unto the said Harmon Page his heirs & assigns and all and every other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 14 day of January one thousand eight hundred and thirty - signed sealed
