Know all men by this present that I Martin Stone of Greenville District and State aforesaid in consideration of five hundred and sixty four Dollars to me paid by Micajah Stone of the State and District aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain and sell and release unto the said Micajah Stone all that plantation or tract of land containing ninety four acres more or less situate in the district aforesaid lying on Saluda River Beginning on a black Gum 3x on said River running thence N 80 E 63.50 to a black Oak 3x bounding on the said Martin Stone's land thence S 49 W 45 to a Beach on the river bounding on J. French's land thence up the meanders of the said river to the beginning. Together with all and singular the rights members and hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining - To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Micajah Stone his heirs and assigns forever - And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Micajah Stone his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand and seal this fifth day of May In the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight and in the sixty second Year of the Independence of the United States of America - signed sealed and delivered in the presence of,
